Clearing browser cache


To clear your browser cache, follow the steps below:

1. Press the keys **Ctrl, Shift** and **del** on your Keyboard.
2. Select the period **since installation**, to empty the whole browser cache.
3. Check the option **Images and Files in Cache**.
4. Confirm your settings, by clicking the button **delete browser data**.
5. Refresh the page.

Alternatively follow the steps relevant to the browser that you are using.

Google Chrome


1. On your computer, open **Chrome**.
2. At the top right, click **More**.
3. Click **More tools, Clear browsing data**.
4. At the top, choose a time range. To delete everything, select **All time**.
5. Next to **Cookies and other site data** and **Cached images and files**, check the boxes.
6. Click **Clear data**.




Internet Explorer

1. Select **Tools** (via the Gear Icon) > **Safety** > **Delete browsing history**

You can also access this menu by holding **Ctrl**, **Shift** and **Delete**.




2. Select the elements you do and do not want to delete and then click **Delete**.
3. You will then get a confirmation at the bottom of the window once it has successfully cleared your data.



Mozilla Firefox

1. Click the **Menu** button  and select **Options**.
2. Select the **Privacy & Security** panel.
3. In the **Cookies and Site Data** section, click **Clear Data**.
4. Select which data you would like to delete.
5. Click the **Clear** button.



Safari

Apple makes it easy: Deleting Safari's Browser cache through a keyboard shortcut

The fastest way to clear your cache is to press **CMD, ALT** and **E**.

Clearing the cache through the developer menu

1. You can also enable a developer menu in Safari to enable several professional options. To display the developer menu:
 2. Select the first item **Safari** in the main menu and from the drop-down the item **Preferences**.
 3. A popup opens. Click on the tab **Advanced**.
 4. Check the option **Show Develop menu in menu bar** at the bottom. Now you should see a new menu item in the main menu named **Develop**.
 5. If you click on the menu item **Develop** you can select **Empty Caches** from the submenu items.
 6. Reload the site.
